## BIBLE VERSES—SET 1

<b>Psalm 3:1</b>	Lord, how are they increased that trouble me! many are they that rise up against me.
<b>Psalm 3:2</b>	Many there be which say of my soul, There is no help for him in God. Selah.
<b>Psalm 3:3</b>	But thou, O LORD, art a shield for me; my glory, and the lifter up of mine head.
<b>Psalm 3:4</b>	I cried unto the LORD with my voice, and he heard me out of his holy hill. Selah.
<b>Psalm 5:1</b>	Give ear to my words, O LORD, consider my meditation.
<b>Psalm 5:2</b>	Hearken unto the voice of my cry, my King, and my God: for unto thee will I pray.
<b>Psalm 5:3</b>	My voice shalt thou hear in the morning, O LORD; in the morning will I direct my prayer unto thee, and will look up.
<b>Psalm 5:4</b>	For thou art not a God that hath pleasure in wickedness: neither shall evil dwell with thee.
<b>Psalm 5:5</b>	The foolish shall not stand in thy sight: thou hatest all workers of iniquity.
<b>Psalm 5:6</b>	Thou shalt destroy them that speak leasing: the LORD will abhor the bloody and deceitful man.
<b>Psalm 5:7</b>	But as for me, I will come into thy house in the multitude of thy mercy: and in thy fear will I worship toward thy holy temple.
<b>Psalm 5:8</b>	Lead me, O LORD, in thy righteousness because of mine enemies; make thy way straight before my face.
<b>Psalm 5:9</b>	For there is no faithfulness in their mouth; their inward part is very wickedness; their throat is an open sepulchre; they flatter with their tongue.
<b>Psalm 5:10</b>	Destroy thou them, O God; let them fall by their own counsels; cast them out in the multitude of their transgressions; for they have rebelled against thee.
<b>Psalm 5:11</b>	But let all those that put their trust in thee rejoice: let them ever shout for joy, because thou defendest them: let them also that love thy name be joyful in thee.

## BIBLE VERSES—SET 2

<b>Psalm 5:12</b>	For thou, LORD, wilt bless the righteous; with favour wilt thou compass him as with a shield.
<b>Psalm 8:1</b>	O LORD our Lord, how excellent is thy name in all the earth! who hast set thy glory above the heavens.
<b>Psalm 8:2</b>	Out of the mouth of babes and sucklings hast thou ordained strength because of thine enemies, that thou mightest still the enemy and the avenger.
<b>Psalm 8:3</b>	When I consider thy heavens, the work of thy fingers, the moon and the stars, which thou hast ordained;
<b>Psalm 8:4</b>	What is man, that thou art mindful of him? and the son of man, that thou visitest him?
<b>Psalm 8:5</b>	For thou hast made him a little lower than the angels, and hast crowned him with glory and honour.
<b>Psalm 8:6</b>	Thou madest him to have dominion over the works of thy hands; thou hast put all things under his feet:
<b>Psalm 8:7</b>	All sheep and oxen, yea, and the beasts of the field;
<b>Psalm 8:8</b>	The fowl of the air, and the fish of the sea, and whatsoever passeth through the paths of the seas.
<b>Psalm 8:9</b>	O LORD our Lord, how excellent is thy name in all the earth!
<b>Psalm 14:1</b>	The fool hath said in his heart, There is no God. They are corrupt, they have done abominable works, there is none that doeth good.
<b>Psalm 14:2</b>	The LORD looked down from heaven upon the children of men, to see if there were any that did understand, and seek God.
<b>Psalm 14:3</b>	They are all gone aside, they are all together become filthy: there is none that doeth good, no, not one.
<b>Psalm 14:4</b>	Have all the workers of iniquity no knowledge? who eat up my people as they eat bread, and call not upon the LORD.
<b>Psalm 14:5</b>	There were they in great fear: for God is in the generation of the righteous.

## BIBLE VERSES—SET 3

<b>Psalm 14:6</b>	Ye have shamed the counsel of the poor, because the LORD is his refuge.
<b>Psalm 14:7</b>	Oh that the salvation of Israel were come out of Zion! when the LORD bringeth back the captivity of his people, Jacob shall rejoice, and Israel shall be glad.
<b>Psalm 18:30</b>	As for God, his way is perfect: the word of the LORD is tried: he is a buckler to all those that trust in him.
<b>Psalm 18:31</b>	For who is God save the LORD? or who is a rock save our God?
<b>Psalm 18:32</b>	It is God that girdeth me with strength, and maketh my way perfect.
<b>Psalm 18:33</b>	He maketh my feet like hinds' feet, and setteth me upon my high places.
<b>Psalm 18:34</b>	He teacheth my hands to war, so that a bow of steel is broken by mine arms.
<b>Psalm 18:35</b>	Thou hast also given me the shield of thy salvation: and thy right hand hath holden me up, and thy gentleness hath made me great.
<b>Psalm 18:36</b>	Thou hast enlarged my steps under me, that my feet did not slip.
<b>Psalm 18:37</b>	I have pursued mine enemies, and overtaken them: neither did I turn again till they were consumed.
<b>Psalm 18:38</b>	I have wounded them that they were not able to rise: they are fallen under my feet.
<b>Psalm 18:39</b>	For thou hast girded me with strength unto the battle: thou hast subdued under me those that rose up against me.
<b>Psalm 18:40</b>	Thou hast also given me the necks of mine enemies; that I might destroy them that hate me.
<b>Psalm 18:41</b>	They cried, but there was none to save them: even unto the LORD, but he answered them not.
<b>Psalm 18:42</b>	Then did I beat them small as the dust before the wind: I did cast them out as the dirt in the streets.

## BIBLE VERSES—SET 4

<b>Psalm 18:43</b>	Thou hast delivered me from the strivings of the people; and thou hast made me the head of the heathen: a people whom I have not known shall serve me.
<b>Psalm 18:44</b>	As soon as they hear of me, they shall obey me: the strangers shall submit themselves unto me.
<b>Psalm 18:45</b>	The strangers shall fade away, and be afraid out of their close places.
<b>Psalm 18:46</b>	The LORD liveth; and blessed be my rock; and let the God of my salvation be exalted.
<b>Psalm 18:47</b>	It is God that avengeth me, and subdueth the people under me.
<b>Psalm 18:48</b>	He delivereth me from mine enemies: yea, thou liftest me up above those that rise up against me: thou hast delivered me from the violent man.
<b>Psalm 18:49</b>	Therefore will I give thanks unto thee, O LORD, among the heathen, and sing praises unto thy name.
<b>Psalm 18:50</b>	Great deliverance giveth he to his king; and sheweth mercy to his anointed, to David, and to his seed for evermore.
<b>Psalm 19:1</b>	The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament sheweth his handywork.
<b>Psalm 19:2</b>	Day unto day uttereth speech, and night unto night sheweth knowledge.
<b>Psalm 19:3</b>	There is no speech nor language, where their voice is not heard.
<b>Psalm 19:4</b>	Their line is gone out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world. In them hath he set a tabernacle for the sun,
<b>Psalm 19:5</b>	Which is as a bridegroom coming out of his chamber, and rejoiceth as a strong man to run a race.
<b>Psalm 19:6</b>	His going forth is from the end of the heaven, and his circuit unto the ends of it: and there is nothing hid from the heat thereof.
<b>Psalm 19:7</b>	The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple.

## BIBLE VERSES—SET 5

<b>Psalm 19:8</b>	The statutes of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart: the commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes.
<b>Psalm 19:9</b>	The fear of the LORD is clean, enduring for ever: the judgments of the LORD are true and righteous altogether.
<b>Psalm 19:10</b>	More to be desired are they than gold, yea, than much fine gold: sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb.
<b>Psalm 19:11</b>	Moreover by them is thy servant warned: and in keeping of them there is great reward.
<b>Psalm 19:12</b>	Who can understand his errors? cleanse thou me from secret faults.
<b>Psalm 19:13</b>	Keep back thy servant also from presumptuous sins; let them not have dominion over me: then shall I be upright, and I shall be innocent from the great transgression.
<b>Psalm 19:14</b>	Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in thy sight, O LORD, my strength, and my redeemer.
<b>Psalm 23:1</b>	The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.
<b>Psalm 23:2</b>	He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters.
<b>Psalm 23:3</b>	He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake.
<b>Psalm 23:4</b>	Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou art with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me.
<b>Psalm 23:5</b>	Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies: thou anointest my head with oil; my cup runneth over.
<b>Psalm 23:6</b>	Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the LORD for ever.
<b>Psalm 24:1</b>	The earth is the LORD's, and the fulness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein.
<b>Psalm 24:2</b>	For he hath founded it upon the seas, and established it upon the floods.

## BIBLE VERSES—SET 6

<b>Psalm 24:3</b>	Who shall ascend into the hill of the LORD? or who shall stand in his holy place?
<b>Psalm 24:4</b>	He that hath clean hands, and a pure heart; who hath not lifted up his soul unto vanity, nor sworn deceitfully.
<b>Psalm 24:5</b>	He shall receive the blessing from the LORD, and righteousness from the God of his salvation.
<b>Psalm 24:6</b>	This is the generation of them that seek him, that seek thy face, O Jacob. Selah.
<b>Psalm 24:7</b>	Lift up your heads, O ye gates; and be ye lift up, ye everlasting doors; and the King of glory shall come in.
<b>Psalm 24:8</b>	Who is this King of glory? The LORD strong and mighty, the LORD mighty in battle.
<b>Psalm 24:9</b>	Lift up your heads, O ye gates; even lift them up, ye everlasting doors; and the King of glory shall come in.
<b>Psalm 24:10</b>	Who is this King of glory? The LORD of hosts, he is the King of glory. Selah.
<b>Psalm 25:1</b>	Unto thee, O LORD, do I lift up my soul.
<b>Psalm 25:2</b>	O my God, I trust in thee: let me not be ashamed, let not mine enemies triumph over me.
<b>Psalm 25:3</b>	Yea, let none that wait on thee be ashamed: let them be ashamed which transgress without cause.
<b>Psalm 25:4</b>	Shew me thy ways, O LORD; teach me thy paths.
<b>Psalm 25:5</b>	Lead me in thy truth, and teach me: for thou art the God of my salvation; on thee do I wait all the day.
<b>Psalm 25:6</b>	Remember, O LORD, thy tender mercies and thy lovingkindnesses; for they have been ever of old.
<b>Psalm 25:7</b>	Remember not the sins of my youth, nor my transgressions: according to thy mercy remember thou me for thy goodness' sake, O LORD.

## BIBLE VERSES—SET 7

<b>Psalm 25:8</b>	Good and upright is the LORD: therefore will he teach sinners in the way.
<b>Psalm 25:9</b>	The meek will he guide in judgment: and the meek will he teach his way.
<b>Psalm 25:10</b>	All the paths of the LORD are mercy and truth unto such as keep his covenant and his testimonies.
<b>Psalm 25:11</b>	For thy name's sake, O LORD, pardon mine iniquity; for it is great.
<b>Psalm 25:12</b>	What man is he that feareth the LORD? him shall he teach in the way that he shall choose.
<b>Psalm 25:13</b>	His soul shall dwell at ease; and his seed shall inherit the earth.
<b>Psalm 25:14</b>	The secret of the LORD is with them that fear him; and he will shew them his covenant.
<b>Psalm 25:15</b>	Mine eyes are ever toward the LORD; for he shall pluck my feet out of the net.
<b>Psalm 25:16</b>	Turn thee unto me, and have mercy upon me; for I am desolate and afflicted.
<b>Psalm 25:17</b>	The troubles of my heart are enlarged: O bring thou me out of my distresses.
<b>Psalm 25:18</b>	Look upon mine affliction and my pain; and forgive all my sins.
<b>Psalm 25:19</b>	Consider mine enemies; for they are many; and they hate me with cruel hatred.
<b>Psalm 25:20</b>	O keep my soul, and deliver me: let me not be ashamed; for I put my trust in thee.
<b>Psalm 25:21</b>	Let integrity and uprightness preserve me; for I wait on thee.
<b>Psalm 25:22</b>	Redeem Israel, O God, out of all his troubles.

## BIBLE VERSES—SET 8

<b>Psalm 27:1</b>	The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? the LORD is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?
<b>Psalm 27:2</b>	When the wicked, even mine enemies and my foes, came upon me to eat up my flesh, they stumbled and fell.
<b>Psalm 27:3</b>	Though an host should encamp against me, my heart shall not fear: though war should rise against me, in this will I be confident.
<b>Psalm 27:4</b>	One thing have I desired of the LORD, that will I seek after; that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the LORD, and to enquire in his temple.
<b>Psalm 27:5</b>	For in the time of trouble he shall hide me in his pavilion: in the secret of his tabernacle shall he hide me; he shall set me up upon a rock.
<b>Psalm 27:6</b>	And now shall mine head be lifted up above mine enemies round about me: therefore will I offer in his tabernacle sacrifices of joy; I will sing, yea, I will sing praises unto the LORD.
<b>Psalm 27:7</b>	Hear, O LORD, when I cry with my voice: have mercy also upon me, and answer me.
<b>Psalm 27:8</b>	When thou saidst, Seek ye my face; my heart said unto thee, Thy face, LORD, will I seek.
<b>Psalm 27:9</b>	Hide not thy face far from me; put not thy servant away in anger: thou hast been my help; leave me not, neither forsake me, O God of my salvation.
<b>Psalm 27:10</b>	When my father and my mother forsake me, then the LORD will take me up.
<b>Psalm 27:11</b>	Teach me thy way, O LORD, and lead me in a plain path, because of mine enemies.
<b>Psalm 27:12</b>	Deliver me not over unto the will of mine enemies: for false witnesses are risen up against me, and such as breathe out cruelty.
<b>Psalm 27:13</b>	I had fainted, unless I had believed to see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living.
<b>Psalm 27:14</b>	Wait on the LORD: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the LORD.
<b>Psalm 32:1</b>	Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered.



## BIBLE VERSES—SET 9

<b>Psalm 32:2</b>	Blessed is the man unto whom the LORD imputeth not iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no guile.
<b>Psalm 32:3</b>	When I kept silence, my bones waxed old through my roaring all the day long.
<b>Psalm 32:4</b>	For day and night thy hand was heavy upon me: my moisture is turned into the drought of summer. Selah.
<b>Psalm 32:5</b>	I acknowledged my sin unto thee, and mine iniquity have I not hid. I said, I will confess my transgressions unto the LORD; and thou forgavest the iniquity of my sin. Selah.
<b>Psalm 32:6</b>	For this shall every one that is godly pray unto thee in a time when thou mayest be found: surely in the floods of great waters they shall not come nigh unto him.
<b>Psalm 32:7</b>	Thou art my hiding place; thou shalt preserve me from trouble; thou shalt compass me about with songs of deliverance. Selah.
<b>Psalm 32:8</b>	I will instruct thee and teach thee in the way which thou shalt go: I will guide thee with mine eye.
<b>Psalm 32:9</b>	Be ye not as the horse, or as the mule, which have no understanding: whose mouth must be held in with bit and bridle, lest they come near unto thee.
<b>Psalm 32:10</b>	Many sorrows shall be to the wicked: but he that trusteth in the LORD, mercy shall compass him about.
<b>Psalm 32:11</b>	Be glad in the LORD, and rejoice, ye righteous: and shout for joy, all ye that are upright in heart.
<b>Psalm 34:1</b>	I will bless the LORD at all times: his praise shall continually be in my mouth.
<b>Psalm 34:2</b>	My soul shall make her boast in the LORD: the humble shall hear thereof, and be glad.
<b>Psalm 34:3</b>	O magnify the LORD with me, and let us exalt his name together.
<b>Psalm 34:4</b>	I sought the LORD, and he heard me, and delivered me from all my fears.
<b>Psalm 34:5</b>	They looked unto him, and were lightened: and their faces were not ashamed.

## BIBLE VERSES—SET 10

<b>Psalm 34:6</b>	This poor man cried, and the LORD heard him, and saved him out of all his troubles.
<b>Psalm 34:7</b>	The angel of the LORD encampeth round about them that fear him, and delivereth them.
<b>Psalm 34:8</b>	O taste and see that the LORD is good: blessed is the man that trusteth in him.
<b>Psalm 34:9</b>	O fear the LORD, ye his saints: for there is no want to them that fear him.
<b>Psalm 34:10</b>	The young lions do lack, and suffer hunger: but they that seek the LORD shall not want any good thing.
<b>Psalm 34:11</b>	Come, ye children, hearken unto me: I will teach you the fear of the LORD.
<b>Psalm 34:12</b>	What man is he that desireth life, and loveth many days, that he may see good?
<b>Psalm 34:13</b>	Keep thy tongue from evil, and thy lips from speaking guile.
<b>Psalm 34:14</b>	Depart from evil, and do good; seek peace, and pursue it.
<b>Psalm 34:15</b>	The eyes of the LORD are upon the righteous, and his ears are open unto their cry.
<b>Psalm 34:16</b>	The face of the LORD is against them that do evil, to cut off the remembrance of them from the earth.
<b>Psalm 34:17</b>	The righteous cry, and the LORD heareth, and delivereth them out of all their troubles.
<b>Psalm 34:18</b>	The LORD is nigh unto them that are of a broken heart; and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit.
<b>Psalm 34:19</b>	Many are the afflictions of the righteous: but the LORD delivereth him out of them all.
<b>Psalm 34:20</b>	He keepeth all his bones: not one of them is broken.

## BIBLE VERSES—SET 11

<b>Psalm 34:21</b>	Evil shall slay the wicked: and they that hate the righteous shall be desolate.
<b>Psalm 34:22</b>	The LORD redeemeth the soul of his servants: and none of them that trust in him shall be desolate.
<b>Psalm 37:1</b>	Fret not thyself because of evildoers, neither be thou envious against the workers of iniquity.
<b>Psalm 37:2</b>	For they shall soon be cut down like the grass, and wither as the green herb.
<b>Psalm 37:3</b>	Trust in the LORD, and do good; so shalt thou dwell in the land, and verily thou shalt be fed.
<b>Psalm 37:4</b>	Delight thyself also in the LORD; and he shall give thee the desires of thine heart.
<b>Psalm 37:5</b>	Commit thy way unto the LORD; trust also in him; and he shall bring it to pass.
<b>Psalm 37:6</b>	And he shall bring forth thy righteousness as the light, and thy judgment as the noonday.
<b>Psalm 37:7</b>	Rest in the LORD, and wait patiently for him: fret not thyself because of him who prospereth in his way, because of the man who bringeth wicked devices to pass.
<b>Psalm 37:8</b>	Cease from anger, and forsake wrath: fret not thyself in any wise to do evil.
<b>Psalm 37:9</b>	For evildoers shall be cut off: but those that wait upon the LORD, they shall inherit the earth.
<b>Psalm 37:10</b>	For yet a little while, and the wicked shall not be: yea, thou shalt diligently consider his place, and it shall not be.
<b>Psalm 37:11</b>	But the meek shall inherit the earth; and shall delight themselves in the abundance of peace.
<b>Psalm 37:12</b>	The wicked plotteth against the just, and gnasheth upon him with his teeth.
<b>Psalm 37:13</b>	The LORD shall laugh at him: for he seeth that his day is coming.

## BIBLE VERSES—SET 12

<b>Psalm 37:14</b>	The wicked have drawn out the sword, and have bent their bow, to cast down the poor and needy, and to slay such as be of upright conversation.
<b>Psalm 37:15</b>	Their sword shall enter into their own heart, and their bows shall be broken.
<b>Psalm 37:16</b>	A little that a righteous man hath is better than the riches of many wicked.
<b>Psalm 37:17</b>	For the arms of the wicked shall be broken: but the LORD upholdeth the righteous.
<b>Psalm 37:18</b>	The LORD knoweth the days of the upright: and their inheritance shall be for ever.
<b>Psalm 37:19</b>	They shall not be ashamed in the evil time: and in the days of famine they shall be satisfied.
<b>Psalm 37:20</b>	But the wicked shall perish, and the enemies of the LORD shall be as the fat of lambs: they shall consume; into smoke shall they consume away.
<b>Psalm 37:21</b>	The wicked borroweth, and payeth not again: but the righteous sheweth mercy, and giveth.
<b>Psalm 37:22</b>	For such as be blessed of him shall inherit the earth; and they that be cursed of him shall be cut off.
<b>Psalm 37:23</b>	The steps of a good man are ordered by the LORD: and he delighteth in his way.
<b>Psalm 37:24</b>	Though he fall, he shall not be utterly cast down: for the LORD upholdeth him with his hand.
<b>Psalm 37:25</b>	I have been young, and now am old; yet have I not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his seed begging bread.
<b>Psalm 37:26</b>	He is ever merciful, and lendeth; and his seed is blessed.
<b>Psalm 37:27</b>	Depart from evil, and do good; and dwell for evermore.
<b>Psalm 37:28</b>	For the LORD loveth judgment, and forsaketh not his saints; they are preserved for ever: but the seed of the wicked shall be cut off.

## BIBLE VERSES—SET 13

<b>Psalm 37:29</b>	The righteous shall inherit the land, and dwell therein for ever.
<b>Psalm 37:30</b>	The mouth of the righteous speaketh wisdom, and his tongue talketh of judgment.
<b>Psalm 37:31</b>	The law of his God is in his heart; none of his steps shall slide.
<b>Psalm 37:32</b>	The wicked watcheth the righteous, and seeketh to slay him.
<b>Psalm 37:33</b>	The LORD will not leave him in his hand, nor condemn him when he is judged.
<b>Psalm 37:34</b>	Wait on the LORD, and keep his way, and he shall exalt thee to inherit the land: when the wicked are cut off, thou shalt see it.
<b>Psalm 37:35</b>	I have seen the wicked in great power, and spreading himself like a green bay tree.
<b>Psalm 37:36</b>	Yet he passed away, and, lo, he was not: yea, I sought him, but he could not be found.
<b>Psalm 37:37</b>	Mark the perfect man, and behold the upright: for the end of that man is peace.
<b>Psalm 37:38</b>	But the transgressors shall be destroyed together: the end of the wicked shall be cut off.
<b>Psalm 37:39</b>	But the salvation of the righteous is of the LORD: he is their strength in the time of trouble.
<b>Psalm 37:40</b>	And the LORD shall help them, and deliver them: he shall deliver them from the wicked, and save them, because they trust in him.

<b>Psalm 51:1</b>	Have mercy upon me, O God, according to thy lovingkindness: according unto the multitude of thy tender mercies blot out my transgressions.
<b>Psalm 51:2</b>	Wash me thoroughly from mine iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin.
<b>Psalm 51:3</b>	For I acknowledge my transgressions: and my sin is ever before me.

## BIBLE VERSES—SET 14

<b>Psalm 51:4</b>	Against thee, thee only, have I sinned, and done this evil in thy sight: that thou mightest be justified when thou speakest, and be clear when thou judgest.
<b>Psalm 51:5</b>	Behold, I was shapen in iniquity; and in sin did my mother conceive me.
<b>Psalm 51:6</b>	Behold, thou desirest truth in the inward parts: and in the hidden part thou shalt make me to know wisdom.
<b>Psalm 51:7</b>	Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean: wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow.
<b>Psalm 51:8</b>	Make me to hear joy and gladness; that the bones which thou hast broken may rejoice.
<b>Psalm 51:9</b>	Hide thy face from my sins, and blot out all mine iniquities.
<b>Psalm 51:10</b>	Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me.
<b>Psalm 51:11</b>	Cast me not away from thy presence; and take not thy holy spirit from me.
<b>Psalm 51:12</b>	Restore unto me the joy of thy salvation; and uphold me with thy free spirit.
<b>Psalm 51:13</b>	Then will I teach transgressors thy ways; and sinners shall be converted unto thee.
<b>Psalm 51:14</b>	Deliver me from bloodguiltiness, O God, thou God of my salvation: and my tongue shall sing aloud of thy righteousness.
<b>Psalm 51:15</b>	O Lord, open thou my lips; and my mouth shall shew forth thy praise.
<b>Psalm 51:16</b>	For thou desirest not sacrifice; else would I give it: thou delightest not in burnt offering.
<b>Psalm 51:17</b>	The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit: a broken and a contrite heart, O God, thou wilt not despise.
<b>Psalm 51:18</b>	Do good in thy good pleasure unto Zion: build thou the walls of Jerusalem.

<b>Psalm 95:1</b>	O come, let us sing unto the LORD: let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation.
<b>Psalm 95:2</b>	Let us come before his presence with thanksgiving, and make a joyful noise unto him with psalms.
<b>Psalm 95:3</b>	For the LORD is a great God, and a great King above all gods.
<b>Psalm 95:4</b>	In his hand are the deep places of the earth: the strength of the hills is his also.
<b>Psalm 95:5</b>	The sea is his, and he made it: and his hands formed the dry land.
<b>Psalm 95:6</b>	O come, let us worship and bow down: let us kneel before the LORD our maker.

<b>Psalm 96:7</b>	Give unto the LORD, O ye kindreds of the people, give unto the LORD glory and strength.
<b>Psalm 96:8</b>	Give unto the LORD the glory due unto his name: bring an offering, and come into his courts.
<b>Psalm 96:9</b>	O worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness: fear before him, all the earth.
<b>Psalm 96:10</b>	Say among the heathen that the LORD reigneth: the world also shall be established that it shall not be moved: he shall judge the people righteously.

<b>Psalm 103:10</b>	He hath not dealt with us after our sins; nor rewarded us according to our iniquities.
<b>Psalm 103:11</b>	For as the heaven is high above the earth, so great is his mercy toward them that fear him.
<b>Psalm 103:12</b>	As far as the east is from the west, so far hath he removed our transgressions from us.

<b>Psalm 133:1</b>	Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity!
<b>Psalm 133:2</b>	It is like the precious ointment upon the head, that ran down upon the beard, even Aaron's beard: that went down to the skirts of his garments;
<b>Psalm 133:3</b>	As the dew of Hermon, and as the dew that descended upon the mountains of Zion: for there the LORD commanded the blessing, even life for evermore.
<b>Psalm 139:1</b>	O LORD, thou hast searched me, and known me.
<b>Psalm 139:2</b>	Thou knowest my downsitting and mine uprising, thou understandest my thought afar off.

## BIBLE VERSES—SET 19

<b>Psalm 139:3</b>	Thou compassest my path and my lying down, and art acquainted with all my ways.
<b>Psalm 139:4</b>	For there is not a word in my tongue, but, lo, O LORD, thou knowest it altogether.
<b>Psalm 139:5</b>	Thou hast beset me behind and before, and laid thine hand upon me.
<b>Psalm 139:6</b>	Such knowledge is too wonderful for me; it is high, I cannot attain unto it.
<b>Psalm 139:7</b>	Whither shall I go from thy spirit? or whither shall I flee from thy presence?
<b>Psalm 139:8</b>	If I ascend up into heaven, thou art there: if I make my bed in hell, behold, thou art there.

<b>Psalm 139:10</b>	Even there shall thy hand lead me, and thy right hand shall hold me.
<b>Psalm 139:11</b>	If I say, Surely the darkness shall cover me; even the night shall be light about me.
<b>Psalm 139:12</b>	Yea, the darkness hideth not from thee; but the night shineth as the day: the darkness and the light are both alike to thee.
<b>Psalm 139:13</b>	For thou hast possessed my reins: thou hast covered me in my mother's womb.
<b>Psalm 139:14</b>	I will praise thee; for I am fearfully and wonderfully made: marvellous are thy works; and that my soul knoweth right well.
<b>Psalm 139:15</b>	My substance was not hid from thee, when I was made in secret, and curiously wrought in the lowest parts of the earth.
<b>Psalm 139:16</b>	Thine eyes did see my substance, yet being unperfect; and in thy book all my members were written, which in continuance were fashioned, when as yet there was none of them.
<b>Psalm 139:17</b>	How precious also are thy thoughts unto me, O God! how great is the sum of them!
<b>Psalm 139:18</b>	If I should count them, they are more in number than the sand: when I awake, I am still with thee.
<b>Psalm 139:19</b>	Surely thou wilt slay the wicked, O God: depart from me therefore, ye bloody men.
<b>Psalm 139:20</b>	For they speak against thee wickedly, and thine enemies take thy name in vain.
